Major Contributions to Sport for Athletes with Impairment:



Braving Chest-below paralysis and spinal tumour treatment for over the past 24 years; Deepa Malik is on a life-long mission of **Ability Beyond Disability**. Deepa Malik hails from an Army Family, with her father, brother, husband and father-in-law all having served in the Indian Army. Throughout her career as a para-athlete and subsequently as an administrator, Dr. Deepa Malik has strived to create a level playing field for athletes with impairments in relation to their able-bodied peers, with regards to grassroots opportunities, government funding, rewards & recognition, job opportunities etc. Her efforts for disability inclusion in sports and all spheres of life has played a major contribution in positively transforming the landscape of para-sports in India, as is evident from India's performance at Tokyo Paralympics and various other international Championships under Dr. Deepa Malik's leadership of Paralympic Committee of India (PCI).

- It has been Dr. Deepa Malik's endeavour to increase the participation of women in disability sports. Dr. Deepa Malik became the first Indian woman to win a Paralympic Medal at Rio 2016; from 2016 to 2023, women's participation in para-sports in India has increased by 200%.

More than 10,000 people have been impacted by the co-founders' workshops, awareness & outreach efforts.

Deepa Malik hails from an Army Family, with her father, brother, husband and father-in-law all having served in the Indian Army. Throughout her career as a para-athlete and subsequently as an administrator, Dr. Deepa Malik has strived to create a level playing field for athletes with impairments in relation to their able-bodied peers, with regards to grassroots opportunities, government funding, rewards & recognition, job opportunities etc. Her efforts for disability inclusion in sports and all spheres of life has played a major contribution in positively transforming the landscape of para-sports in India, as is evident from India's performance at Tokyo Paralympics and various other international Championships under Dr. Deepa Malik's leadership of Paralympic Committee of India (PCI).

**B. Voluntary Services for National Paralympic Committee of Pakistan
27 December 1998 to – date:**

Background: In addition to my own duties as Instructor in National Training Centre for Special Persons, I also served as the Sports Coordinator during my entire service there. I organized various indoor and outdoor sports events for the students of the Institute and Inter-schools competitions. I also attended various coaches' clinics / workshops. In October 1998, I along with my other colleagues successfully organized a Regional Sports Rally at Islamabad wherein 250 athletes with disabilities from various parts of the country participated. The rally was a great success as the talent demonstrated by the athletes with disabilities provoked a thought in my mind for establishment of a national representative organization of sports for persons with disabilities that could open doors and create opportunities for athletes with disabilities of Pakistan for their participation in international and regional sports competitions, as there was none before. My initial research in the matter revealed that Pakistan participated in Atlanta Paralympic Games 1996 with two athletes and one Chef de Mission. I also came to know that the International Paralympic Committee used to contact the Ministry of Social Welfare & Special Education to enable Pakistan's participation in the Paralympic Games. For the team that participated in the Atlanta Games, it was a pleasure trip as the athletes were picked up and taken to the games without any professional training and observing the prescribed procedures. Further study enabled me to understand the Paralympics sports management system and generated the idea of establishment of National Paralympic Committee of Pakistan. Finally, with the approval of my Ministry, I and one of my Directors took the initiative and formally established the NPCP. We invited one of the retired Federal Secretaries who was rendering voluntary services as President of Parents Teachers Association of National Special Education Centre for Mentally Retarded Children, Islamabad those days to become the President of NPCP. Within a period of 06 months we were able to form a general assembly of the NPCP and held elections. Initially, I was elected as Joint Secretary of NPCP and Mr.Ashiq Hussian Soomro as its Secretary General. Later, Mr.Hussain moved abroad permanently and I was shouldered with the responsibility of Secretary General of NPCP and still working in the same capacity. We worked day and night and in addition to our duties to the government to enable

NPCP to acquire sustainability and keep developing. Following, paragraph about NPCP will give its evolution since 1998:-

National Paralympic Committee of Pakistan (NPCP) is a sole representative organization of International Paralympic Committee, registered and recognized by the Government of Pakistan as the only body with the mandate to represent before the IPC and to deal with sports for the disabled in the country. It is a bonafide member of the Asian Paralympic Committee (APC) and other International Disabled Sports Federations. The status of NPCP is at par with Pakistan Olympic Association that deals with sports for athletes without disability. Since its inception in December 1998, the National Paralympic Committee of Pakistan has been able to organize 55 Training camps, 28 National sports Championships and 08 National Paralympic Games including one exclusively for women with disability. Besides, the NPCP has also been successful in ensuring participation of athletes with disability in international / regional sports events. Our athletes with disability while competing on international sports standards have secured **78** medals comprising **25 Gold, 29 Silver** and **24 Bronze** Medals.

My work input and achievements from establishment to evolution of NPCP at the current stage and my participation in various regional and international sports competitions as Chef De Mission of Pakistan Team as given in annexure to this C.V would reflect the level of my understanding and comprehension and skills on sports management system, sports rules, classification issues etc. And I still need to strengthen myself to serve the organization and the athletes with disabilities at large more professionally.

In the year 2009, my personal strenuous endeavors converted into establishment of South Asia Para Sports Federation with its headquarters in Islamabad – Pakistan. In 2010 when we arranged a very first meeting of South Asian Countries in Islamabad I stand as one of its Vice Presidents since then. We are still striving hard for promotion of Paralympic Movement in Pakistan, South Asia and Asia as there is lot to be done and in a professional manner.
